GIANT INDIAN rushed up under his own power along the inside to assume a forward position, went at it head to head with MY MAN DAN briefly down the backstretch before gaining a respite, drifted into the two path for the beginning of the run around the bend, had no sooner done when confronted by rivals from each side, sparred with them until the quarter pole, continued to argue with the outer member of the pace dispute after entering the stretch, dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. DOUBLESPEAK raced from off the inside, was already under some encouragement midway on the turn, fanned five wide into upper stretch, had a good finish down the center of the strip to garner place honors in the last jump. MY MAN DAN grabbed a forward post soon after the start, challenged the winner for command from the three path while AMERICAN BUFFALO was simultaneously doing so but only from down along the fence, spun into the lane still locked in combat with the top one, fought with vigor to the end but had to settle for the show for all effort. TONINTHIRTEEN raced from off the rail, was already under urging turning for home, mustered a good kick to take the last major check. SHOOTDEWORX sat under a snug hold towards the two path and well within striking distance, remained under restraint bidding time from behind the front runners from the five-sixteenths marker until the head of the stretch, got called upon but failed to fire appreciably. BIG CREEK placed six wide at the top of the lane, kicked in with mild energy to improve position. AMERICAN BUFFALO crept up from the pocket to make his presence leaving the half mile pole, argued with another pair from the inside around the turn, stayed a prominent factor until nearing the end of the furlong grounds before backing away. RED JACK well placed

stalking the front runners under a firm hold by the pilot, was angled outward in preparation for the stretch drive from the five-sixteenths pole, had no kick. JACKIN MY STYLE took the overland route and had little left for the stretch run. FREUDIAN THERAPIST saved ground and failed to menace.
