MR ROSENTHAL established control soon after the start, worked out a tuck along the inside just after departing the homestretch, proved ratable setting the splits on a loosely-contested lead, faced some challenges for the initial time heading for the quarter pole, drifted out slightly after setting foot into upper stretch, leaving the inner flank exposed, had IN MY EYS waste no time availing of the golden opportunity and came under heavy pressure from that opponent with the runner up issuing a challenge of his own one path further to the outside, showed true grit battling from between that pair during the final furlong to prove best. SLEEPY FREUD took the inside route for just over three-quarters pole, slipped to be two wide prior to reaching the head of the stretch, tipped out slightly more still for optimal clearance shortly afterwards, fought tooth and nail with the other in the money finishers for over a furlong down the stretch en route for the place. IN MY EYES was rated along tracking the leader from the pocket, turned for home with sufficient passage awaiting along the rail and moved up directly alongside the winner, sparred with the first two finishers for most of the stretch drive but could only grab the show award. POWERFUL INSTINCT rode the rail, cut the corner into the lane, had the rider be forced to remain on hold mired in traffic from upper stretch until the sixteenth pole, angled outward for freedom and came home with belated interest. LORD OF LOVE off the inside, finished willingly under a strong hand ride. WHY NOT WHISKEY saved ground, came home with belated energy. WISHINGONADREAM three wide around both turns, weakened. GOSSIP COLUMN failed to get involved. HOPE STILL SPRINGS placed to a snug hold for a good portion of the way down the homestretch, prompted the pacesetter from the outside until the top of the lane before backing away. OWEN RICO sputtered a good four to five wide entering the opening bend, settled into the three path in short order, remained in the same lane around the subsequent one, failed to reach a contending position.
