SAINT ARTHUR grabbed the early advantage, was guided over to the rail departing the backstretch, had the runner up latch on and initiate an intense duel that lasted from the seven-sixteenths pole all the way to the wire, appeared to be getting a bit leg weary during the last eighth, but dug in gamely to prevail over PLEASANT PRINCIPLE and while remaining well clear of all the others who had no stretch response. PLEASURE PRINCIPLE drew on even terms with the winner at the crown of the turn, engaged in a spirited tussle with that foe, drawing off to their lonesome selves during the run around the bend, was still going at head with the top after entering the stretch, with the rest having been left in their dust, started getting a bit let weary from his earlier efforts as was the chief nemesis, continued onward in game fashion nonetheless to earn the place award. AMBERJACK rode the rail for nearly a half, angled outward spinning into the stretch, went on to best the rest. NAIL IT bobbled inward, brushing with BIG BREEZY as a result, gave futile chase on the duelers on the turn and tired. UNBRIDLED BAND saved ground until the quarter pole to no avail. SINISTRA three wide on the turn, was outrun. BIG BREEZY brushed at the start, raced from off the inside between rivals for a good way on the turn, failed to contend. TAKE THE EL TRAIN off two beats slowly, departed the backstretch from the four path, trailed throughout.
