FOGGY ROAD underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, picked up interest coming to the quarter pole, got put to a drive, scampered away making his way from upper to midstretch, held on safely, driving. WESTERN GRIT got angled off the rail coming to the end of the bend, mustered up a good kick, fell short.

LUCCI THE LION stumbled at the start, was between rivals leaving the half mile pole, swung four to five wide into the stretch, came home with good energy to secure the show. FORCE MULTIPLIER raced from off the inside and rallied willingly to take the last major check. STONE ROCKS three wide entering the turn, was about four wide exiting it, closed the gap belatedly. KELTIC FIGHTER dueled for command from the inside and backed away in the final furlong. PATRIOTIC DUTY had a ground-saving journey. MY WAY OR DUBAIWAY chased three wide on the turn and tired. DAN THE IRISHMAN travelled in the two path on the turn. BANZAI KID disputed the pace from the two path and faltered. MR. G. ZEE placed along the rail at the seven-sixteenths pole, retreated. INDIGENE CHARM three wide at the half mile pole, folded. DENSE FOG COVERED THE TRACK.
