Footnotes

DISTANT STRIKE was well placed while saving ground for six furlongs, swung between horses while three wide at the quarter pole, surged to the front in midstretch and prevailed after a long drive. HAWSER raced in the middle of the pack, was in traffic between horses in upper stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and rallied belatedly. PERFECT BOOM steadied in tight on the first turn, closed the gap leaving the turn, raced in traffic in upper stretch and finished well to narrowly miss the place. ROYAL LORD raced in hand along the rail, steadied along the inside in upper stretch, altered course to the outside nearing the eighth pole and closed late in the middle of the track. TRAMEZZINI chased four wide to the top of the stretch and lacked a late response. PEACEFIELDS pressed the pace from outside, took the lead nearing the quarter pole and weakened in midstretch. GOOD KARMA checked at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. VERVEITUP was never a factor. GYPSY GENT was used up setting the early pace. MAJESTY'S PILGRIM was carried wide on the first turn, faded after going a half.
