Footnotes

GIMME CREDIT reserved between rivals for the initial five furlongs, was taken out to the three path leaving the five-sixteenths pole, in preparation for the stretch drive, swung from that path into the stretch, took off in earnest after being straightened away, closed the gap with strong strides, continued onward, collaring the leader just before the finish line to prove best. COMPLIANCE OFFICER off and running leaving the starting gate, was taken hold of and eased back, assuming the role of stalker, applied mild pressure on the leader while attending the pace from the outside, moved up to issue a challenge for the lead coming to the quarter pole, poked a head in front turning for home, spurted away during the run through the furlong grounds, felt the top one's presence in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, dug in stubbornly before reluctantly yielding a few yards before the wire. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS was bumped soundly after the start, advanced into a forward position during the run leading up to the opening bend, sat well placed from there under a good hold, failed to respond positively once called upon at the quarter pole getting outfinished during the stretch drive. CHERNOBYL'S HERO raced three wide around each turn, ranged up on the second turn, but failed to sustain the bid after turning for home. MIDNIGHT MASS bumped after the start, saved ground and failed to

menace. CITY SNEAKERS broke running, set the pace from the inside and gave way after completing three-quarters. MIGHTY TUFF a bit rank fighting the bit during the opening stages, acted more kindly once reaching the backstretch, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled outward but lacked the necessary stretch response. CITIFEST was bumped at the hind quarters about two jumps after the start, recovered in short order and took up residence in the pocket, tracked the leader under a snug hold, was called upon in upper stretch but failed to fire. HOT MONEY three wide on both turns, tired steadily after a half.
