ADAMS CIRCLE was lightly urged to grab the early lead, was gradually guided over towards the inside down the chute, eventually settling into the two path, showed the way, being rated and facing only mild pressure, was let out a notch turning for home, then held sway under good handling. B Z WARRIOR unhurried during the opening six furlongs, displayed a good finish along the inside in the lane. HURRICANE HEAT chased the leader from the two path and rallied for the show. BRILLIANT SON patiently stalked the leader three wide for three-quarters pole, was set down in upper stretch and got outfinished. STOPBLUFFING urged during a four wide pursuit on the turn, had no solid kick. FRENCH TRANSITION tired after a half. WADI SUKI five wide around the turn, folded. COPPER CASCADE always outrun, took the inside route for six furlongs, swung to be widest of all at the top of the lane to no avail.
