QUIPPERY placed under a good hold soon after the start, was well spotted just behind the pace activity on the turn, was kept on hold, awaiting options approaching the quarter pole, found ample room angling three wide into the stretch, took off after the front runners after receiving mild hand encouragement, soared by to take charge with an eighth to go and held sway, with intermittent stick work. WILD BANSHEE unhurried during the opening half while racing along the outside, picked up the pace turning for home, was denied her first attempt to angle outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, brushing with ERIS in the process, succeeded during the second effort, closed in good energy during the final furlong, but had to settle for place honors. CHROME CRUISER nibbled continuously on the left side of the bit while racing well off the inside, was positioned four wide by the three-eighths pole, during the run around the bend, swung from that path into the stretch and came home willingly en route for the show. FLEEING FAST hustled away from the gate, was outprinted for the lead nonetheless, moved up nearing the half mile pole, disputed the lead from between rivals, remained a prominent factor until the eighth pole and weakened. WEAK DOLLAR POLICY mildly roused leaving gate, flashed good acceleration to grab the early lead, was put to a snug hold once sufficiently clear, felt pressure by the time she reached the turn, vied with two other opponents while taking the inside route around the bend, held her ground until the furlong grounds before backing off. ERIS three wide, vied from there with a duo, brushed with the runner up in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and steadily tired thereafter. LOVELY LINA trailed.
