FAIR WHIT broke to the front despite breaking outwards at the start, set the pace from the three path, was confronted by his closest pursuer nearing the quarter pole, got headed at that station, came under encouragement at the three-sixteenths and dug in stubbornly, came back on even terms near the sixteenth pole and wore down his only foe to just prevail in the final stride. BIG HERMAN tracked the pace while four wide down the backside as the closest pursuer, came under hand urging near the head of the lane and took command, was fully roused at the quarter pole and gained a slight advantage by the eighth pole, fought on through the furlong grounds losing the bob at the wire while well clear for second. CORRECT RESPONSE settled towards the rear early on, was placed in the two path in the turn, began to pick up position on his own from midway on the turn, came under a drive at the head of the lane and steadily rallied for the show spot. THISSKYSABEAUTY was bumped lightly at the start by his inside rival, saved ground through the turn, came under a prolonged drive midway, offered a mild bid along the rail and secured the last major share. CINNAMON BEACH broke out at the start bumping THISSKYSABEAUTY making light contact before being pulled off by the rider, tracked the pace from the two path thereafter, was let out near the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and steadily tired. VOLCANO RUN loped along in midpack early on, came under a drive midway on the turn and offered no response. MASTER JOHN saved ground throughout and was never a factor. SANDRA D'ORO trailed throughout.
