RACE TO URGA worked out a tuck into two path just before reaching the first turn, was unhurried for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest angling outward at the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch, responded positively when given her cue, collared the drifting leader near the sixteenth pole and edged away under good handling. ALLURING POWER away well from the starting gate, quickly established control, set the pace, well rated and placed slightly off the inside, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, got asked for a response as the pressure from the closest pursuers intensified at that station, began to drift outward incrementally after setting into upper stretch, got caught by the top one with about a sixteenth to go, held well to secure second. ONE LAST DANCE stayed within range from off the inside, was asked for run approaching the end of the backstretch, split rivals in upper stretch and rallied mildly for the show. MYSTIC CITY tracked the leader from the pocket, availed of sufficient clearance along the inside to launch a bid from the quarter pole, sustained it during the ensuing furlong before flattening out. UNIQUE CITIZEN placed five wide at the head of the stretch, went on to improve position. DECENNIAL lacked the needed response. STAR TORINA outrun for the initial six furlongs, went by weak and tired ones down the lane. RESOUNDINGLY pulled off a foe at the start, saved ground to no avail. SEX APPEAL swung three wide into the backstretch, remained

well off the inside thereafter and was no menace. SETTLING SEAS accompanied the pacesetter from the outside until the quarter pole before backing away. AFAAF strung out three wide on the first turn, continued to race along the outside and tired.
