MUSICAL broke slowly, advanced four wide on the turn, dug in gamely in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. CAJUN TWO STEP was rated inside, responded when roused and finished gamely. DRAX HALL raced wide and finished well outside. ROYAL BANQUET was hard-held between rivals early, put in a four wide run on the turn and lacked a solid finishing kick. ECO ALFA showed speed while between rivals, was bumped on the turn and dropped back. SHAGADELLIC showed speed while three wide and tired. IWWRITETHESONGS raced with the pace along the inside while under wraps, was bumped on the turn, steadied and dropped back.
