B.'S ANNIE broke slowly, was outrun early, rallied inside on the turn and was going well late. SANSA contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. SEVEN MOONS (JPN) was bumped after the start, put in a three wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. LA PIQUE DAME was bumped after the start and had no response when roused. MAE'S MON had no rally. EMERALD GREEN was bumped after the start and tired. ROTOTILLER tired. ITALIANA tired badly and was eased in the stretch.
