WIND CAPER away in good order, patiently stalked the leader from the two path, moved when ready to issue a challenge for the lead coming to the quarter pole, put a head in front turning for home, kicked clear during the ensuing furlong and widened out under hand encouragement to the wire. VERSE CHOIR unhurried down the backstretch, gradually advanced into contention from the outside during the run around the bend, was asked for run angling three wide into the stretch and rallied willingly to secure the place. SUPER SLASH bumped at the start, raced four wide around the turn, rallied mildly for the show. SPECKLEDBIRD coaxed along, underwent a three wide pursuit and tired. TEMPEST STORM bumped with SUPER SLASH, after bobbling at the start, moved up to grab early command, showed the way towards the inside, offered brief resistance when confronted by the top one and gave way. KISSA MELISSA failed to menace. SNEAKY GIRL off a beat slow, was outrun. VAUGHNDIDIT forwardly placed along the inside during the initial stages, faded.
