ENCHANTED STONE away well from the gate, was allowed to settle into his long stride, bided time until nearing the half mile pole, picked up the pace, under light urging, departing the backstretch, was put to much stiffer encouragement leaving the five-sixteenths pole, swung from the four path into the stretch, lugged in momentarily in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, in response to a right handed shot from the whip, was quickly yanked back to the outside, closed in strongly once straightened away under steady right handed stick work, drew abreast of the leader just past the sixteenth pole, rolled on by and edged away. BLUE ROCK was pulled off HARDROCKER after breaking out a bit at the start, assumed command soon after the start, was comfortably rated in the two path on a loosely-contested lead, kicked clear of the field turning for home, was initially put to hand urging during the early portion of the stretch drive, was switched to right handed pressure after starting to drift outward, failed to match the top one's speed, yielding readily, but continued onward with good courage to procure the place. COLLABORATE chased outside and was outfinished. ROSEMONT DRIVE saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. HARDROCKER off to a sluggish beginning, failed to menace. CAMILLUS DRIVE prompted the pacesetter while travelling three wide, appeared to be weakening when steadied off a rival's heels coming to the three-sixteenths pole.
