**Footnotes**

MISS MEXIQUE broke well to the front, set the pace in hand while under no direct pressure, continued in the two path around the turn, cut the corner along the rail as they turned for home feeling pressure for the initial time by her closest pursuer, was let out in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths and responded well, dug in in the final furlong holding his only worry at bay to the wire while being kept busy. PROUD DAME tracked the pace under a patient good hold, maneuvered three wide around the turn, was let out near the quarter pole and responded well closing the gap readily to within a length, couldn't go by the top one while being well clear for second. QUITE A FEAT crossed to the middle soon after the start, tracked the pace from the rear, opted to be four wide around the turn, came under a drive just past the five-sixteenths, rallied mildly in the furlong grounds to procure the show. FALL INTO FAITH ducked in at the start forcing in SCHILLERY, saved ground along the rail throughout, cut the corner into the straightaway while under a long drive that commenced at the five-sixteenths to procure the last major share from a tiring rival. FEELS GOOD bided time early on, steadily improved position under no urging down the backside and around the turn, rallied into contention coming to the quarter pole, couldn't sustain that bid in the final eighth and tired. CITY RANSOM tracked the pace for three quarters, was three wide in the turn and faltered. SCHILLERY forced in at the start by an errant FALL INTO FAITH, recovered and opted to chase the pace while four wide down the backside, took the overland route in the turn, came under encouragement midway and was never in contention. ANG RITA stumbled at the start, chased for a half and tired. SO BE IT RACHAEL prominent early on, steadily dropped back through the run in the backstretch, crossed to the fence entering the turn, got called upon midway, offered no response, was eased in the final eighth.
