JENA JENA stumbled at the start but quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, turned back a bid from YOUTEBETTERBELIEVEIT in upper stretch and drew clear under a drive. PENTELIS, outrun early, rallied inside, angled out and finished gamely to get the place award. YOUTEBETTERBELIEVEIT rallied three wide on the turn, tried the winner in upper stretch but could not get by that rival and was outfinished for the place. BIOGIO'S BABY lacked a rally. NEVADA LIGHTS chased the pace and tired. SWEET E. L. A. had no response when roused. NATALARIA was outrun. MICH'S PITCH tired after showing brief speed. STRIKING MOVE chased on the rail and tired.
