INTO MY SOUL within range while racing three wide, made his bid approaching the top of the stretch, fought his way to the front at the furlong marker and edged away under driving tactics. KEEPING THE HONOR underwent a four wide journey and finished willingly to be up late for the place. WINTHROP HOUSE chased the pacesetter for three-quarters, advanced towards that rival to loom a threat with a furlong to go, but was outfinished from that point on. PEGASUS TOMMY D. tracked the leader from along the inside, lacked the necessary stretch response. WESTERN FABLE set the pace while being firmly rated, remained prominently placed until the eighth pole, then was steadied while tiring in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole. LIME RICKEY was never involved. RELATIVELY READY tried to reach contention while racing five wide on the second turn, flattened out. KARAKORUM LEGEND trailed.
