FASTUS CACTUS bumped lightly with HALF A NOTE after bobbling at the break, assumed command soon afterwards, set the pace while drifting to the outside steadily throughout the running of the race and held safe under constant right handed pressure during the last eighth. THE ZIPSTER chased the winner from the get-go and salvaged the place. RAMSGATE angled three wide into the stretch under a drive and rallied mildly for the show. ACES MARK saved ground and weakened during the final furlong. KILN CREEK failed to menace. ONE STARRY NITE lightly bumped at the start, was through after a half. HALF A NOTE bumped lightly at the start, was no factor. J J'S PROPHET was never in the hunt. LEMON SHORE was outrun.
