Footnotes

YANKEE KITTEN away in good order, tucked along the rail soon after departing the elbow chute, took the inside route, while matching the rating tactics being applied by each other rider, bided time for nearly three-quarters, was put to encouragement, being asked to pick up the pace coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was taken outward a furlong later, made minimal progress initially, then finding his stride upon reaching the eighth pole, closed with a belated burst of energy to prevail. SCHOOLYARD CAT forwardly placed throughout between rivals under a good hold, displayed a good kick en route for the place. RAFFIE'S CHOICE three wide around both turns, displayed a good late kick to grab the show. MORE THAN LUCKY perched three wide around both bends, was outfinished during the stretch run. FREUD'S DEBUT rated stalking the pacesetter, weakened during the final furlong. LEMON PEEL well rated along the inside until the quarter pole, gave way. BIGGER IS BETTOR three wide around the opening bend, worked his way into the two path before reaching the second one, turned for a home with a wall of rivals scattered about directly ahead, dove inside for clearance in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was stalled in the midst of a good rail rally approaching the sixteenth pole, being taken in hand to avoid running up on a couple of weakening rivals, angled outward for freedom too late to seriously menace thereafter. WELL BUILT lunged at the break, tracked the leader while saving ground and tired. Igoturback off the inside, never threatened. BURNING SHORE saved ground until the quarter pole and was always outrun.
