STORMY'S MAJESTY away in good order, patiently stalked the leader under a good hold towards the two path, made a quick bid to take command in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, spurted off when let out a notch in upper stretch and held sway under steady encouragement to the finish line. NOT ABROAD strung out four wide around bend, finished gamely to earn the place. TEAKS NORTH was steadied while in a bit tight leaving the homestretch, the end result of some jockeying for position during the run around the first turn, went on to brush with OVERCOMMUNICATION as well, sat well reserved for nearly three-quarters in the two path, was asked to pick up the pace at the five-sixteenths pole, bumped lightly with DOMINANT JEANNES angling outward at the three-sixteenths pole, was set down immediately afterwards and continued on willingly to grab the show. OVERCOMMUNICATION stumbled badly at the start, losing some ground and momentum in the process, rushed back into midpack before reaching the first turn, moved along a bit headstrong into the pocket, brushing with TEAKS NORTH and acting rank fighting against the bit, settled down entering the backstretch, now placed just off the leader's heels, rode the rail, was put to encouragement coming to the three-eighths pole, slipped outward a sixteenth down the road, steadily tired during the final furlong. GOLDEN MOKA away alertly, established command, was rated on the lead from the rail, was put to test by the top one departing the backstretch, and readily succumbed. AL MUHTASIB underwent a wide journey, travelling around the opening bend from the three path, unable to work his way closer to the inside, continued along on the wide journey, was urged on the far turn to keep pace, commenced his stretch drive from the five path at the top of the lane, but had nothing left to offer by this time. DOMINANT JEANNES had a wide journey, was tiring when brushed by TEAKS NORTH in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole.
