Footnotes

MEGALITHIC moved up willingly leaving the gate to assume the role of stalker, patiently tracked the leader from the two path under a snug hold, continued to bide time until leaving the five-sixteenths pole, crept up to reach nearly even terms with the pacesetter, heading into the stretch, was asked for run simultaneously with GREAT PRIVILEGE by upper stretch, fought his way to a clear edge with an eighth to go then drew away under good handling. PRECIOUS METAL sat reserved along the outside towards the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, began to pick up the pace approaching the quarter pole, swung from the five path into the stretch, lugged inward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, badly impeding LIVING RIGHT and bumping with that opponent as a result, continued onward, closing with good energy down the outside of the course to be the unofficial place horse at the end. GREAT PRIVILEGE placed under a firm hold at the start, wasted little time establishing command, cut the fractions from the inside, well rated on a loosely-contested lead, felt some pressure for the initial time coming to the quarter pole, responded with gusto when set down in upper stretch, offered good resistance before relinquishing the front a short distance from the eighth pole, then proceeded to hold his ground well enough to take the show. MIDNIGHT MAX entered the backstretch from the three path, remained well off the inside thereafter, was positioned four deep at the five-sixteenths pole, gearing up for the stretch run, then finished willingly to procure the last major share. MAJESTIC RAFFY saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. LIVING RIGHT off the inside, swung four wide into the stretch, was bothered and bumped into by PRECIOUS METAL in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole,

bobbling noticeably and being checked shortly afterwards, attempted to get going once more, but had little impact on the outcome from that point. QUIET POWER tracked inside and faded after going three-quarters. HARLAN'S POINT three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, tired. MIGHTY J retreated after a half. ERNIE THE SHOE was always outrun. After a claim of foul lodged by the rider of LIVING RIGHT against the rider of PRECIOUS METAL, the latter was disqualified from second and placed sixth for causing interference in upper stretch.
