PERNICE was strung out three wide on the opening bend, was placed in the four path on the backstretch and unleashed a run from there during the run around the far turn to reach a good striking position, lost none of the momentum entering the stretch, drew on even terms with the leader in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, took over soon afterwards and edged away. SUPERESTRELLA sat well reserved in midpack from off the inside for nearly three-quarters, angled towards the middle of the course at the eighth pole and kicked in with good, but belatedly energy to secure second. WON O WON saved ground until midstretch, rallied willingly enough for the show. ROYAL ACT bobbed after the break, disputed the pace from the two path, made a successful challenge for command at the five-sixteenths pole, gained ground well before weakening slightly in the final sixteenth. DYNAMITE DUDE lacked the needed response. EUROPEAN ROULETTE tracked the front runners towards the inside for the opening six furlongs, faltered. RAJADESAMINAUX was brushed while in tight soon after the start, took the second turn from the three path, tired after entering the stretch. WIN THE DAY squeezed back at the start, was no factor. SPECIALE GIORNO bumped at the start, was sluggish early, failed to reach a contending position. THE BUTLER DID IT underwent a three to four wide journey, folded. CONCORDE COUNTY got bumped lightly while in tight amongst rivals making their way towards the exit from the chute and onto the homestretch, vied for command from the inside and gave way. LA FESTA E DOMANI was never in contention.
