Footnotes

WESTSIDE CORRAL rode the rail while lagging behind for nearly six furlongs, was taken hold and eased back prior to angling outward nearing the quarter pole, took off with good energy after settling into upper stretch, split rivals in mid lane while appearing full of run, wrested away the lead with about a sixteenth to go and edged away. SKY BLUE PINK unhurried, picked up the pace late on the far turn, was fanned six wide, the widest of all, into upper stretch, came home with good energy down the center of the course to garner place honors. STRONG IMPACT raced from off the inside, drafted behind

BISHOP OF NOLA from the three path into stretch, tipped outward, closed well to take the show. WISHFUL TOMCAT pressed the pacesetter from the outside, made a successful challenge for the front at the five-sixteenths pole, was still in possession of a slim advantage with a furlong remaining, but with several others in hot pursuit, gave in to the pressure a sixteenth later and weakened slightly thereafter. ISN'TLOVEJUSTGRAND cut the corner into the lane and rallied. GIMME CREDIT three wide on the far turn, displayed a mild stretch response. MAJESTIC RAFFY took the inside route, made a run from upper to midstretch before flattening out. PRECIOUS METAL tracked the leader from the pocket, squeezed to be two wide nearing the quarter pole, came up empty in the stretch drive. BISHOP OF NOLA forwardly placed while three wide, tired. LONELY WHISTLE well off the inside throughout, was through after completing three-quarters. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS underwent a three to four wide journey, folded. ALLTIFFEDOFF showed the way from the inside and faltered.
