**Footnotes**

HEAD HEART HOOF was lightly hustled from the gate, set a pressured pace from the two path around the turn, was fully called upon near the three-sixteenths, dug in through the furlong grounds, held well under a drive to the end. COALTOWN LEGEND rear early on, took the overland route throughout the turn, spun four wide into the stretch under encouragement, angled inside near the three-sixteenths, got on track in the final furlong rallying willingly for the place along the inside. SHREWD ONE bided time early on, maneuvered four wide around the turn, continued four wide swinging for home, came under a ride near the three-sixteenths, was herded a bit outwards a path just past the eighth pole, continued on unaffected with good energy to garner the show down the center of the course. BOUND BY HUMOR coaxed along early on down along the rail, came under a drive at the quarter pole, angled out one path herding a tiring WON GREAT CLASSIC into two rivals to his outside just past the eighth pole, finished with an even rally thereafter for the last major share. DAHLGREN CHAPEL forced the pace while two to three wide around the turn, was roused nearing the quarter pole, continued on well until the final sixteenth, flattened out. RAYNICK'S JET midpack throughout, was called upon straightening away for home, got herded out one path just past the eighth pole through a chain reaction begun when BOUND BY HUMOR angled out at that point, lacked a bid. WON GREAT CLASSIC prompted the pace three wide around the turn, came under a full drive by the quarter pole, was bumped and herded just past the eighth pole when BOUND BY HUMOR came out, in turn bumped RAYNICKS JET in a chain reaction, and tired. STEAL THE SHOT saved ground throughout, came under a prolonged drive through the turn and offered no response.
