MAGICALMYSTERYCAT raced close up inside, advanced on the rail approaching the stretch, found a large opening along the rail in upper stretch, moved on through, drew clear and was driving under the line. SAHARA GOLD, unhurried outside, rallied wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely outside. SILENTLEA, unhurried early, rallied inside nearing the stretch, altered course in upper stretch, went back to the rail in midstretch and finished gamely. PROPOSAL chased the pace while four wide and continued on gamely to the finish. RUBY PARK contested the pace while between rivals and weakened in the final furlong. VALERIE'S DREAM, far back early, was going well too late outside. FRENCH MADAM contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. TRANQUILITY JANE contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
