ICABAD CRANE was bumped at the start, was outrun early, raced inside, dug in determinedly on the rail and got up in time. AFOREMENTIONED contested the pace from the outside, drew clear when roused, took a clear lead into deep stretch and was caught nearing the finish. BLIZZARD CITY raced four wide and lacked a rally. CAPE OF STORMS raced five wide and had no response when roused. ITS GOODTOBEKING chased the pace while three wide and tired. OLD KIT BAG raced greenly along the inside and had no rally. CASTLE HARBOUR raced between rivals and tired. DUKE OF DE BUQE was bumped at the start and tired after a half mile. MARSCAPONI was outrun along the inside. BURNISHED COPPER was bumped at the start, contested the pace along the inside and tired.
