ARE WE DREAMIN raced along the outside, was mildly urged to keep pace during the run around the bend, received more energetic encouragement after turning for home, settled into her rally approaching the eighth pole, grabbed the lead at the sixteenth pole and edged away under a brisk drive. SUPER SLASH stalked the pacesetter from the two path, made her bid for the lead after entering the stretch, drew alongside the leader with a furlong to go, was joined by the top one soon afterwards, failed to match strides with that rival, but continued on with good courage to garner place honors. WYATT'S WOMEN set the pace while racing towards the inside, was put to the test nearing the furlongs grounds, offered resistance until the sixteenth pole before weakening. SNEAKY GIRL underwent a three wide trip and lacked a rally when called upon. PRECISELY THAT was no factor. BIG EASY saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. RINELLA STORM trailed.
