Footnotes

CHORUS MUSIC patiently stalked the leader from the outside, was taken out to the three path just past the five-sixteenths pole, angled from there into the stretch, responded well once given her cue, closed in on the leader, wrested the lead away at the sixteenth pole and edged clear under brisk hand encouragement to the finish line. KELLY'S PIC off to an alert beginning, needed little if any encouragement to establish command, set the pace from the inside, with rating tactics being applied by the rider, was let out a notch turning for home, felt the top one's presence coming to the sixteenth pole, offered brief resistance before yielding the front, but continued onward with good courage to well clear of the others for place honors. CHICK IN SLACKS worked out a tuck into the two path in the nick of time before the run around the opening bend, bided time from there down the backstretch, was guided into the three path leaving the backstretch, swung four wide into the lane, full of run, gained readily down the center of the course en route for the show. SWEET MADNESS within range along the outside, lacked the necessary stretch response. LOYAL SHADOW took the inside route, rallied mildly into contention after entering the stretch, but soon flattened out. JAZZY MOVES improved position belatedly. UNIQUE CITIZEN leapt up just as the gate was being sprung open, causing her to strike the left side, maneuvered over to and rode the rail around the first turn, was eased off the inside midpoint on the backstretch, came up

empty when called upon in upper stretch. PRETTY B was off slowly after throwing her head sideways at the start, resulting in her hitting the right side of the gate, saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. LIGHTS OUT LISA attended the pace from the outside for three-quarters and folded. SWEET AS YOU ARE was through after a half.
