RULE BY NIGHT bobbed at the break, recovered in short order to assume a forward position, kept a watchful eye on the pacesetter during the opening half, moved when ready, glided past BANK HEIST, with the rider sitting motionless, to take over coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was put to encouragement after settling into upper stretch, drew out to what proved to be an insurmountable advantage and proceeded to widen out with authority during the final furlong, remaining under a brisk hand ride to the finish line. SUNRISE SMARTY underwent a three wide pursuit and held on in time to procure the place. DIXIE NOTION angled four wide into the lane and narrowly missed second. BANK HEIST well rated cutting the early fractions from the rail, readily succumbed once challenged by the top one in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and steadily tired thereafter. MAD FOR SMARTY failed to menace. REMAND came four wide into the stretch but could not muster up a solid offering. CLOSE TO THE EDGE saved ground until the quarter pole and faded.
