STORM GAL broke running to grab the early lead, set the pace towards the inside, was asked for a response turning for home, and dug in under good handling during the stretch drive to hold sway. INDIAN RUSH was bumped at the break, ducked over to the rail just past the three-eighths pole, moved forward during the latter portion of the run around the bend, was slightly off the leader's heels as the field turned for home, angled outward to continue her bid, failed to significantly cut into the front runner's lead, altered course a second time at the eighth pole, this time over to the rail, had dead aim with a sixteenth to go, but wasn't good enough. AEGEAN BREEZE underwent a three wide pursuit and held well to grab the show. GENTLE RIDE was quickly guided over to the rail, required strong pressure on the left side of the rein after showing signs of trying to come out, in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, went on to rally mildly to earn the last major award. DISCO DIVA hustled away from the gate, failed to reach a forward position nonetheless, raced along the outside around the turn, was checked off a tiring rival's heels coming to the three-sixteenths pole, losing ground and momentum as a result, angled outward to steer clear of that opponent, and came back out a bit to flash some interest. FIONA FREUD was bumped after stumbling badly at the start, took up chase from midpack, swung four wide into the lane and tired. CHICKS ARE BETTER outrun, attempted to commence to rally from the five path at the head of the stretch, but had no offering. CHAKA BWANA hard used early, gave way.
