**Footnotes**

TAG V EYE assumed the role of stalker soon after the start, moved up to sit positioned just off the leader's hind quarters after entering the backstretch, bided time until nearing the quarter pole, took off in earnest after being roused in upper lane, steadied momentarily coming to the eighth pole, after the pacesetter suddenly swerved out, took over soon after leaving the furlong grounds, then dug in stubbornly to fend off the runner up, bravely ignoring the lugging antics being displayed by that opponent throughout the final sixteenth. WALKER'S LANDING settled towards the back of the pack after leaving the starting gate, showed instant acceleration after being taken outward at the half mile pole, boldly circled four to five wide past rivals to reach a good contending position, lugged in repeatedly throughout the stretch drive, with the rider engaging in a constant state of tug of war with his mount to maintain a truer course, was carried out a bit by the errant pacesetter midstretch, continued on gamely from there, but had to settle for the place. KING TING (IRE) was rated on the lead along the inside until the quarter pole, was let out after turning for home, swerved out suddenly coming to the eighth pole, relinquished the lead soon afterwards and steadily weakened thereafter. RIVER LEMON unhurried for nearly three-quarters, improved position belatedly. UNCLE CARM took up in residence in the pocket soon after the start, rode the rail until upper stretch, angled outward, commenced to rally, was placed in hand and taken inward, when the leader came outward in the vicinity of the furlong marker, all done without missing a beat the whole time, flattened out during the final sixteenth. CHINGLISH saved ground and was no factor. WAR COLONY off slowly after lunging at the break, raced three wide around the first turn and had no rally. DIXIE COWBOY four wide around the second turn, folded. RISKIER took the inside route and tired. ISCAR raced three wide around the far turn and retreated.
