Footnotes

WON FAST BULLET loosely drafted behind the runner up while in the two path around the turn, tipped a bit wider turning for home and was asked for some run, cut into the pacesetter's advantage during the ensuing furlong, made progress much more readily thereafter, arriving at the sixteenth marker on nearly even terms, put a head in front afterwards then inched away in the final seventy yards. HOLD THAT BROAD quickly established control, sat entrenched in the two path showing the way on an open lead, lightly coaxed along to maintain interest, felt a wisp of pressure nearing the quarter pole and was soon let out in response, had the winner hitch up with about a sixteenth to go, reluctantly yielded, but continued onward to be second best. ALSTON GUNTER underwent a three wide pursuit, was asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed pick up in speed. JEMARU saved ground throughout, was let out a notch in the form of brisk hand encouragement late on the turn and advanced on the leader, flattened out departing the eighth pole. LINCOLN PENNY took the inside route on the turn, had no rally. SMALL TOWN raced along the outside and tired. NO QUESTIONS cut the corner under a drive, came up empty. NEVER CONTENT checked at the start, raced from off the inside, fell back steadily during the run around the bend, was eased entering the stretch, pulled up by midlane then subsequently vanned off. ALSTON GUNTER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM THIRD TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
