SENTIMENTALROMANCE contested the pace from the outside, drew clear in the stretch and continued on gamely to the wire. BEL BAIE was bumped at the start, put in a four wide run on the turn and had little left for the drive. DRAMA QUEEN raced close up inside, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. DRAWING A BLANK was bumped at the start and had no rally. GEM'S WAGER had no response when roused. QUPPY raced inside and had no rally. BARELY PERFECT contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
