Footnotes

INDEPENDENCE WAR was boxed in behind a wall of horses on the turn, got through along the rail to challenge in midstretch and edged clear under good handling. MISSILE MOTOR was reserved early, gained three wide between horses on the turn, surged to the front in midstretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. UNBRIDLED DANGER steadied along the inside at the half mile pole, saved ground to the turn and finished willingly. JACOB'S RUN was outrun early, ranged up four wide to reach contention at the quarter pole and flattened out. TIMBER CRUISE steadied sharply in traffic at the five-eighths pole and failed to threaten thereafter. ELTISH STAR trailed after breaking slowly, circled five wide and passed only tiring horses. MORINE'S VICTORY pressed in the two path and gave way in upper stretch. CALL TIGER was never a factor. BROOKS STAR was used up setting the early pace.
