SILVER PRIZE raced three wide for most of the way around the bend, was about one path challenging the runner up in earnest as the pair spun into the stretch, imitated the previously named rival by drifting outward while making his way towards the wire, fell back slightly to more than a length behind with a sixteenth remaining, forged on ahead and began to narrow in once more, got up late despite getting carried out by FIJIANA for the final few jumps. FUJIANA chased the leader from the outside on the turn, grabbed command before reaching the quarter pole, arrived at that station three wide and facing stiff pressure from the winner, edged away from upper stretch until the sixteenth pole despite steadily drifting outward, was still in the process of doing so but failed to intimidate the top one and got caught near the wire. SIMPLISTIC stalked the front runners and proved no match. LOUDER THAN SOUND saved ground until the five-sixteenths marker and had no rally. GOLDEN CHEETAH strung out four wide at the midway point on the turn, was outrun. EVA LIL failed to menace. CURIOUS DREAM GIRL broke slowly, getting away awkwardly and ducking inward at the break, took the three path for most of the way around the turn, tired. CAREY PRINCESS vied for the lead from the outside down the backstretch, tucked over to the rail just past the half mile pole, had the second place finisher draw directly alongside less than a furlong later, yielded to that foe's pressure, and steadily faded.
