FLAT BOLD forwardly placed two to three wide under patient handling, was given his cue at the three-sixteenths, took over the front at the eighth pole, inched clear under a mild hand ride to prevail. LINDELL A. C. vied from just off the inside with MARQUET CAT down inside, shook off that foe nearing the quarter pole inching away, came under a drive straightening away, offered little resistance when overhauled at the eighth pole, ran on well to be second best and well clear of the rest. MARQUET CAT broke in bumping MR. VANTASTIC at the start, shifted to the rail nearing the five-eighths pole to range up inside and vie for command in the early going under light coaxing, was placed to further urging at the five-sixteenths, got shaken off a bit nearing the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch while able to procure the show honors. VICTORIOUS LEADER tracked the pace from in behind in the two path, came under encouragement spinning three wide in upper stretch and offered no serious response. MR. VANTASTIC off a beat slow and bumped lightly at the start by MARQUET CAT who broke in slightly, was outrun early on while saving ground detached and last, then proved no menace when asked at the five-sixteenths. MISSILE MOTOR three to four wide in close range of the front, took a bad step approaching the seven-sixteenths, was immediately protected and pulled up by the rider and subsequently vanned off.
