FRISKY CAT veered out at the start, settled in mid pack just off the inside, came under encouragement swinging six wide into the lane, offered up a good kick moving in tandem with SONNYANDPALLY and PROFESSOR CHAOS, on the lead duo the outermost of a quintet stacked across the track heads apart a sixteenth from home, dug in under vigorous urging to get up at the wire. SONNYANDPALLY hesitated at the start, tracked inside just off the pace, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, spun four wide for home, offered up a good kick and just missed among a quartet at the wire. PROFESSOR CHAOS forwardly placed three wide, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered five wide for home, kicked home with good energy between foes through the stretch but was outfinished for the top two spots while earning the show. RIVER TUNE set the pace inside, was roused swinging three wide at the quarter pole, dug in stubbornly unwilling to let HIDDEN VOW by through to the sixteenth pole when confronted by a new trio outside, kept on battling to the wire but was overhauled in the last jumps and forced to settle for the last major share. HIDDEN VOW keen early on, was well held just off the inside in close attendance of the pace, swung four wide for home under a drive, could not get by the leader as that one dug in stubborn, was in the thick of the battle when jostled between foes and squeezed out of his lane inside the final sixteenth as the outside trio arrived on the scene. TOWER IN COURT three wide towards the rear, got asked at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide in upper stretch, offered up late foot while making no impact. POST PATTERN three wide in mid pack, got set down swinging just off the inside into the stretch and weakened late on. SUNNY SOL RIO saved ground towards the rear, swung six to seven wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild kick while making no impact. THISPLACEONTHIRD saved ground in mid pack, was asked cutting the corner into the stretch and tired. LITTLE BRIT detached and last in the early going, was never involved.
