CAIXA ELETRONICA left the starting gate without apparent mishap and assumed the role of primary pursuer, took up the chase down the backstretch and beyond from the two path, needed some hand encouragement by the three-eighths pole to keep pace, turned for home under much stronger handling, closed in readily during the ensuing furlong to draw abreast of THIS ONES FOR PHIL with a furlong to go, grabbed charge soon afterwards and kicked clear, finishing the race under a brisk hand ride. THIS ONES FOR PHIL broke on top, set fast fractions from the rail on a loosely-contested lead with the pilot attempting to keep a little in reserve, felt the top one's presence by the head of the stretch, went on a little further down the road before getting called for run himself, arrived at the furlong marker holding a precariously narrow advantage, saw it all gone by the sixteenth pole, continued onward with good energy though to be second best. MINE OVER MATTER stumbled badly at the break, tucked along the inside coming to the end of the backstretch, was already under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, made no impact. SMALL TOWN TALK left the gate being hand roused, was grabbed hold after joining up with the rest of the others, departed the backstretch two wide and was put to back to encouragement a sixteenth later, ducked over to the rail a short distance into the stretch run and faltered. WILLY BEAMIN underwent a three wide pursuit, was asked for some run making his way from beginning to end on the turn, spun into the lane and was grabbed hold, drifted out slightly during the initial portion of the stretch drive, fell back steadily then was reported to have bled.
