RIVER BOSS gave chase from the three path on the bend, ranged up towards the front runners as the third fraction was being set, entered the stretch and got asked for his best, gave it, arriving at the eighth pole as the new leader, dug in well enough long enough in the late stages to fend off the second place finisher. BEDOUIN NOW was significantly forced inward by an errant LIFE'S A ROAR at the start, departed the backstretch from the four path and steadily advanced towards the leader, with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, left the turn as wide as entering it and got set down to a drive, closed in on the winner but fell short. GRIFFIN ROCK got knocked sideways a few strides into the event, as a result of pressure initiated by the outermost breaker, sat well reserved two wide within range of the front runners during the run around the bend, spun slightly wider into the stretch and was asked for run, was taken in hand after the winner drifted in a bit past the three-sixteenths pole, altered course to the outside right afterwards, causing a bumping incident that affected two others directly to his outward at that juncture, continued onward by had to settle for the show award. SIR LESLIE raced at or near the inside for

almost six furlongs, got taken outward and turned for home five wide, was put in tight between rivals and bumped from both sides deep into the furlong grounds, after GRIFFIN ROCK had changed course, maintained a mild response the rest of the way home for the last major check. HUDSON MIRACLE raced from off the inside, swung six wide into upper stretch, went on for a couple strides and made contact with SIR LESLIE, lacked the needed late response. KATMANSTU carried in right after the start, checked after making solid contact with GRIFFIN ROCK, fanned about seven wide, the widest of all, into upper stretch and mainly improved position. LIFE'S A ROAR broke sharply inward leaving the gate, caused some crowding and bumping as a consequence, went on to assume a forward position, stalked the pacesetter from the two path, attempted to challenge in earnest as the field headed home, wasn't up to the task and backed away. TRAININGFORSUCCESS tracked the leader from the inside, arrived at the five-sixteenths marker having already been asked for run, tired. SPIRIT OF PEACE cleared the field after the start and was sent over to the inside, was put to the test approaching the quarter pole, succumbed in short order and faltered. SCORPION BOY faded off a ground-saving journey. An objection lodged by the rider of GRIFFIN ROCK against the rider of RIVER BOSS alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
