GEAUX METS tracked the pace along the inside, cut the corner roused into the stretch, seized command just outside the eighth pole, edged clear in the late stages kept to task. ELECTRIC CURRENCY just off the inside in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home, offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors in the late stages. MAYBRY'S CHALLENGE on the pace through solid splits just off the inside attended on the inside by GEAUX METS, got roused at the quarter pole, dug in under challenge and was headed nearing the eighth pole then weakened in the final sixteenth while holding safe for the show. COFFEE AND DONUTS two to three wide towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, spun six wide for home, kicked on belatedly for the last major share. MARGIN OF VICTORY just off the pace tracking inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, bid mildly into upper stretch before weakening in the late stages. FULL PADS brushed the near side stall at the start, settled three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths and offered no response. METROPOLITAN STORM away well, settled two to three wide in mid pack, commenced a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and weakened. PERFECT DANCING outrun early on detached from the main body of the field, came under encouragement at the midway point on the turn and made no impact. TELEVISION TOO stumbled at the start, chased three wide in aim of the front under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home and tired.
