Footnotes

SALLY'S DREAM sat forwardly placed right from the get-go, departed the backstretch appearing eager, was forced to bide time, pilot atop with a firm grip on the reins until the later stages of the run around the second bend, gained maneuverability and slipped outward to be three wide a couple of jumps prior to the quarter pole, spun into the stretch and went on for just a little while longer before getting asked for run, gave it, out racing the runner up to poke a head down in front with an eighth to go, gradually kicked away, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. LADY'S LUNAR LUCK underwent a ground-saving journey, was kept on hold closely drafting behind the winner while making her way on the far turn, had sufficient room to cut the corner into the stretch and did so, picked up speed very shortly afterwards, rallied in tandem with the top one towards the pacesetter, slipping by the latter in midstretch, forged on ahead willingly but had to settle for the place. MAH JONG MADDNES darted over to the rail after the start, rode it for six furlongs, paused before getting put to encouragement entering the stretch, continued to fan outward until in the four path midway through the furlong grounds, displayed a good kick to earn the show. PHILIPPIS quickly established control, rated kindly while cutting the pace on a loosely-contested lead for nearly three-quarters, arrived at the head of the stretch facing heavy pressure, was between rivals yielding the lead at the eighth pole, weakened steadily thereafter. EZPZ LEMON SQUEEZE strung out four wide on the opening bend, had no rally. FIRST WHIPPOORWILL three wide on each bend, had no response. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER attended the pace from the two path for six furlongs before giving way. ORIGINAL KITTEN reserved along the outside between rivals for a good portion of the

opening three-quarters, tired. BAAL PERAZIM threw her head just as the gate was being sprung open, lunging up enough to make contact with the right side of the starting gate, took the three path around both turns and tired.
