POLISH POSH contested the pace from the outside, drew clear in the stretch, lugged in in deep stretch but remained well clear, driving. JOHN'S JET raced close up outside, raced greenly while four wide and rallied outside to get the place prize. B. CARSON contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. MY BUDDY DUDDIE was bumped soundly after the start, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. SAFARI was outrun early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch drive. HIGH PRICED was bumped soundly at the start and had no rally. KINGS TEMPER was bumped soundly at the start, raced five wide and tired in the stretch. DISTINCTIVE ED raced inside and had no response when roused. GRIND THE BLUES was bumped soundly at the start, raced wide throughout and tired. NEW YORK'S RUDY showed brief speed while between rivals and tired. SOUP SPOON was knocked back from between rivals after the start, dropped far back early and tired. MR. MOBO was knocked back from between rivals after the start, was taken up sharply, dropped far back early and tired.
