NEFERTINI assumed a forward position soon after the start, was rated along stalking the leader with head cocked slightly towards the left, remained unhurried while attending FANTASY FLIGHT from the three path for almost six furlongs, made a successful bid shortly before reaching the quarter pole to take over and lead the field into the stretch, got asked for run, had the runner up draw alongside with an eighth to go, drifted outward slightly carrying out WILLET in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, showed good determination to stave that opponent off and preserve the decision. WILLET raced from off the inside, under a firm hold by the pilot for nearly three-quarters pole, ranged up into a good striking position during the later stages of the run around the bend, tipped slightly more to the outside in upper stretch while in the midst of her rally, latched on to the winner at the furlong marker, was dueling with the foe when carried out about a path in deep stretch, battled onward gamely but got denied. HARD LIFE loped along in the initial stages, picked up interest when let out a notch while angling outward at the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch drive being three wide, closed in on the front runners, ducked inward in response to the drifting incident with about a sixteenth to go and continued to gain ground on the top pair en route for the place. R GYPSY GOLD moved up while taking the inside route down the backstretch, tracked the front runners, getting asked for some run after more than halfway around the turn to keep pace, was set down to stronger handling once settled into upper stretch, ventured towards the two path, but made no headway. FANTASY OF FLIGHT grabbed the advantage, cut the pace kept two wide, under a firm hold in the opening stages, got overhauled by the winner approaching the quarter pole, then retreated steadily.
