ROMANTIC NOVEL quickly showed in front, controlled the pace, drew away when roused and was kept busy while well in front through the stretch. MARLA SUE came wide into the stretch and was along to get the place prize. CHEROKEE SILVER chased the pace and tired. ZIPPER PYE lugged in in the stretch and tired. SAGE FIRE raced inside and was checked along the rail in the stretch. OUT OF PLACE BELLE was taken up sharply after the start, her rider losing his irons in the process. FINALLY was outrun. COUNTESS FLEET tired. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, ZIPPER PYE was disqualified from fourth position and placed fifth for interference in upper stretch.
