LADY DIPLOMAT was rated between rivals, rallied inside turning for home, angled out in midstretch and finished gamely. FAVORITE ENDING was outrun early and offered a mild rally inside. ERIN MOOR raced inside and had no rally. QUEEN CANDACE raced close up outside while in hand and tired after a half mile. GOLD PASSAGE chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. DECADENT DESIGNER had no response when roused. CARNA chased inside and tired.
