LEFT BANK contested the pace from the outside while in hand, drew clear when roused in upper stretch and remained clear under a drive. GRAEME HALL chased the pace while four wide and finished gamely to earn the place. RED BULLET bobbled at the start, was bumped, was hustled outside, rallied five wide on the turn and finished gamely outside. VOLPONI was bumped at the start, chased the pace while between rivals and stayed on well through the stretch. AFFIRMED SUCCESS stumbled at the start, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. PEEPING TOM was unhurried inside, came wide for the drive, was bumped in upper stretch and had no rally. TICKET TO FREEDOM was outrun early, raced wide and had no response when roused. CAPSIZED was hustled along early, was steadied in upper stretch and had no rally. ILLUSIONED was hustled along inside, broke down in upper stretch and was vanned off.
