### Footnotes

RAHYS' APPEAL stumbled at the start, was unhurried early, put in a quick three wide run approaching the stretch, responded when roused and drew away after his rider inadvertently struck MALIBU MINT with his whip. MALIBU MINT was bumped after the start, raced close up outside, rallied three wide and weakened after being struck by the winner's whip. MISS SHOP was bumped after the start, was outrun along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. YOLANDA B. TOO quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. CARMANDIA raced outside early, was wide throughout and had no response when roused. MO CUISHLE was bumped after the start, chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. Following a Stewards' inquiry concerning the stretch run as well as a claim of foul against the winner by the rider of the second place finisher, alleging interference in the stretch, RAHYS' APPEAL was disqualified from first position and placed second.
