BANROCK raced close up early while in hand, rallied three wide on the final turn and drew clear under a drive. STEPASIDE raced in hand along the inside, saved ground and rallied to get the place. SPANISH HARLEM (IRE) raced with the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. THE SHAUGHRAUN was outrun early, put in a five wide run on the last turn and faded in the stretch. WINEMASTER raced inside and had no rally. ROMP (ARG) raced wide throughout and had no rally. EXTON was outrun early, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. MY MAN LARS had no response when roused. RIZ SAUVAGE chased the pace from the outside and tired. AMBASSADOR DAN set the pace along the inside and tired.
