Footnotes

COURT VISION raced close up along the inside, came out for room entering the stretch, bumping BIG TRUCK and placing that rival in tight quarters between rivals, then bumped soundly with TRUST N DUSTAN in upper stretch, dug in gamely and got up in the final strides. ATONED clipped heels on the first turn, stumbled, rallied three wide on the second turn, drew clear in the stretch and was caught nearing the finish. TRUST N DUSTAN was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn, was bumped turning for home and again in upper stretch and was outfinished. BIG TRUCK was rated along early, was forced to steady on the first turn, was roughed up between rivals into the stretch, was taken up and dropped back. SPRINGS ROAD came out on the first turn, was steadied then chased the pace and tired in the stretch. TIDE DANCER set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. Following a Stewards' inquiry concerning the stretch run, as well as the dismissal of a claim of foul against the winner by the rider of the fourth place finisher, the result was declared official.
