EAST OF DANZIG away in good order from the starting gate, was taken hold after appearing uncomfortable between rivals shortly before reaching the opening bend, rated more kindly soon afterwards, after settling towards midpack, placed in the two path, bided time from there down the backstretch, was taken three wide for the run around the second turn, spun from there into the lane, bumped with VOODOO STORM just past the three-sixteenths pole, with both parties bearing some responsibility for the incident, forged on ahead under encouragement, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, took full advantage of the turbulence just behind to open up a clear advantage, then held sway under good handling. ADIRONDACK SUMMER was well placed while taking the inside route, commenced his bid after turning for home, was forced to steady when placed in tight quarters in the vicinity of the eighth pole, losing ground and momentum as a result, got going again, squeezed by SUMMER IN GIZA near the sixteenth pole while rallying, then finished with good courage from there to grab the place. KID CURRY unhurried for nearly three-quarters, was four wide at the five-sixteenths pole and came home with good energy down the outside of the course en route for the show. SUMMER IN GIZA well in hand after the start, established command in short order, cut the pace slightly off the inside, with the rider applying rating tactics, continued along on the same scenario until nearing the quarter pole, was let out a notch with

several rivals in close proximity and in hot pursuit, was still in the thick of the battle when slammed into by an errant VOODOO STORM at the eighth pole, failed to show any real interest thereafter. VOODOO STORM raced within range during the opening six furlongs, swung three wide into the lane, was coming inward at same time the winner was coming outward, resulting in both rivals bumping into each other, around the three-sixteenths pole, proceeded to veer in sharply a few strides later, while full of run, torpedoing SUMMER IN GIZA in the process, and soon flattened out. LINEAR MOTION rank while being steadied along the inside during the early stages, was no factor. SILENT TAP became rank when taken in hand off a rival's heels approaching the first turn, was steadied along while travelling three wide around that bend, and failed to reach a contending position thereafter,. GO MAIRE TU accompanied the pacesetter from the outside until upper stretch and gave way. CONGO three wide around both turns, was forwardly placed for six furlongs and folded. HOPE FOR TODAY off a beat slowly, trailed throughout. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run before the result was declared official.
